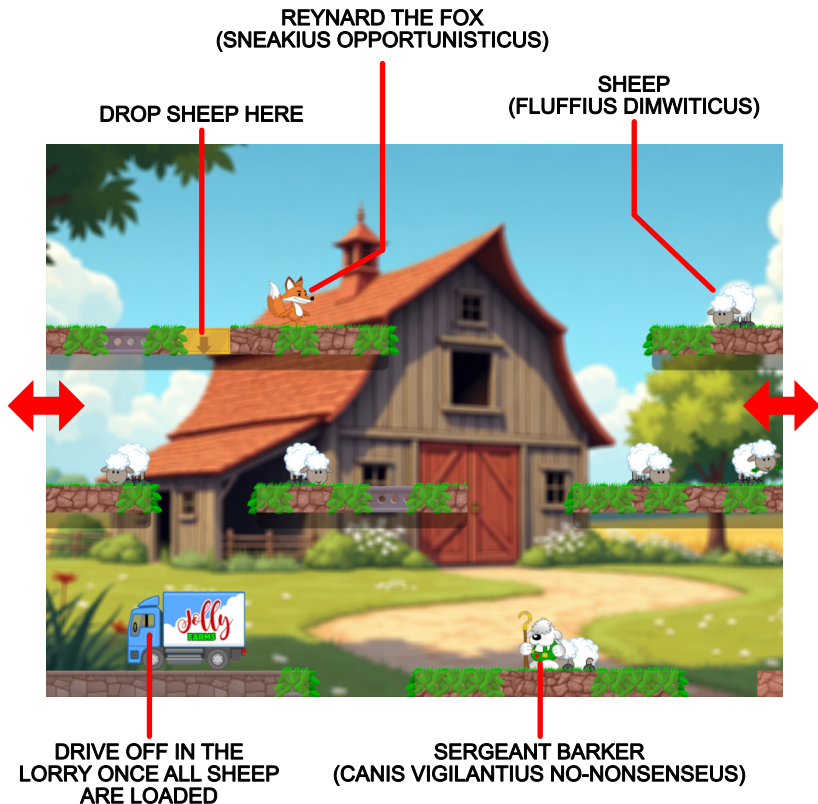
It's a battle of wits: one fox. One sheepdog. Dozens of thoroughly bewildered sheep.

Sheep aren't the only things lurking around these farms. Later levels introduce new troublemakers — best figure out how to handle them when they show up.

If a screen is proving to be far too much for you, just press N and move onto the next. Technically, yes, it's cheating, but I won't tell if you won't.
