LOADING INSTRUCTIONS

SPECTRUM: 48K owners type LOAD""(ENTER). 128K owners select 48K basic.

AMSTRAD: 464 Hold down **CTRL** and tap the small **ENTER** key.

664/6128, type](shifted @ TAPE (ENTER) then type RUN "(ENTER).

C64/128: Hold down **SHIFT** and tap the **RUN/ STOP** key, 128K owners ensure that it is in **64K** mode.

PLAYING THE GAME:

To select an **option** or **category** use the following keys:
